Program Schedule

- Working Hours: 6 hours/day, Monday to Friday
- Target Groups: Local youth, children, and the broader community

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

- Age Range: 18 to 30 years old.
- Background Check: No criminal record (mandatory due to work with children).
- Inclusion Policy: Open to all, regardless of race, class, gender, sexual orientation, or education level.

Accommodation and Support

- Living Arrangements: Volunteer will be provided with suitable accommodation in Skopje, ensuring safety and comfort.
- Financial Support: Monthly stipends for food, local transportation, and pocket money foreseen through the European Solidarity Corps Programme.
- Transportation: Local travel costs covered (monthly public transportation passes or bicycles available).
- Language Training: Basic Macedonian language courses will be offered to enhance daily interactions.

Training Opportunities

1. Pre-Departure and On-Arrival Training

- Familiarize with Eco-Logic's mission, values, and goals.
- Gain practical guidance on living and volunteering in North Macedonia.

2. Mid-Term Evaluation and Reflection

- Assess progress and share experiences with fellow volunteers.
